

## Nissan Titan gauge face instructions

When installing Stainless Steel Gauge Faces, always wear the gloves included in kit. Touching these with your bare hands could leave finger prints on them..

Step 1. Using template on back, Start the vehicle, and make a sketch of where the needles are pointing, while the vehicle is running...



Step 4. Now pull off the plastic bezel that surrounds the instrument cluster..



Step 7. Remove all the needles by using the Needle Removal Tool insluded. Hold the need with 1 hand while sliding



Step 10. Once the gauge face is on, plug instrument cluster back in, and start vehicle.



Step 2. Pull the lower plastic piece down below the steering column. (There is no screws holding this in)



Step 5. Remove the four 7mm screws holding the instrument cluster in place, and unplug...



Step 8. Peel off the stock gauge face...



Step 11. With the vehicle running, In reference to the sketch you made in step 1, Lightly push on the needles where they were pointing.



Step 3. Remove the 3 phillips head screws holding the plastic piece around the column. (This will come off in 2 pieces, a top and bottom)



Step 6. Once the cluster is out, remove the front lens from the cluster by lifting on the tabs as pictured, and pull off..



Step 9. While wearing supplied gloves, peel off sticker back of the new gauge face and apply to cluster.



Step 12. Once all the needles are on turn the vehilce off then start again. Make sure they are properly positioned, and push down just alittle.

Always make sure the needles are not touching the gauge face, this will cause them to stick..
